

SOUTH PETHERWIN PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of South Petherwin Parish Council was held in the Village Hall on Wednesday August 10th 2011.

Present Vice Chairman Cllr T Goodman, Councillors: Mrs L Archer, P Parsons, A Patterson, Mrs D Rogers, M Screech.

Apologies Chairman Cllr A Hosking, Councillors: Mrs C Davies, P Vernon, J Whiting. Cllr Screech apologised for not attending the July meeting.

Representations from the public Three members of the public attended the meeting to express their opposition to planning application PA11/04847.

- 11/147 Minutes The minutes of the meeting held on July 13th were approved and signed proposed by Cllr Parsons seconded by Cllr Patterson.
- 11/148 Declarations of interest Cllr Mrs Rogers declared a private interest in application PA11/04847, Cllr Screech declared a prejudicial interest in application PA11/04847.
- 11/149 Roads It was reported that surveys are still being carried out at Trekelland Bridge, there is a possibility that new structures will be put in place to slow down traffic. Long term improvement to Plusha junction on the A30 are being looked into, this is likely to cost £5m.
- 11/150 Bangors Tip Development of the new site is progressing, the colour of the boundary fence has been agreed.
- 11/151 Old School House It was agreed that the wording for car park sign recommended by Rev'd Probert was inappropriate, it was proposed by Cllr Mrs Archer that a sign with the parish council's original wording (Parking for Church and Village Hall use only) be purchased, proposal seconded by Cllr Parsons, proposal carried.
- 11/152 Parish Event It was decided that a future parish event to celebrate the Queens jubilee be considered in the near future.
- 11/153 Play Project There is no more news on this matter.
- 11/154 Village Shop There is to be a public meeting to discuss the village shop project on August 24th Cllr Mrs Archer reported that there is a possibility that if the project is not up and running by December the shop will be closed, there is also a possibility that the Post Office services will be reduced in the future.
- 11/155 S.P.I.V.S. The Parish Clerk has been informed that the majority of the S.P.I.V.S. equipment has been given to the allotment society and the rest is to be auctioned in the near future.
- 11/156 Audit The audit has been signed off by the District Auditor with no queries.
- 11/157 Fly Tipping It was reported that the dustbin containing asbestos has not yet been cleared.

- 11/158 Cornwall Council Cllr Parsons reported that diesel has been stolen recently from lorries at Trecrogo.
The new strategic plan states that 54,000 dwellings are to be built in Cornwall.
- 11/159 Correspondence As attached list.
- 11/160 Planning PA11/04847 Mr T Gale. Change of use of partially built commercial building and construction of new dwelling.
Land at Tremeal Manor South Petherwin.
It was decided to adjourn the meeting and visit the site before a decision was made. Following the adjournment and site visit it was decided that the council would not support the application.

It was proposed by Cllr Mrs Archer that the accounts be paid, proposal seconded by Cllr Screech, proposal carried.
- 11/162 Code of Conduct A questionnaire had been received from Cornwall Council regarding proposed government legislation and future codes of conduct, Cllr Mrs Rogers had been asked to complete the questionnaire, it was proposed by Cllr Parsons that the council accept Mrs Rogers answers and forward to Cornwall Council, proposal seconded by Cllr Mrs Archer, proposal carried. Cllr Mrs Rogers was thanked for completing the document.
