A meeting of South Petherwin Parish Council was held in the Village Hall on Wednesday May 11th 2011.

- 11/083 Minutes The minutes of the meeting held on April 13th were approved and signed, proposed by Cllr Patterson seconded by Cllr Goodman.
- 11/084 Declarations of Interest No councillors declared an interest in any matter on the agenda.
- 11/085 Dog Waste Bin The contract to empty the bin has been signed by Mr Oak.
- 11/086 Roads Trekelland Bridge has been damaged by a vehicle again. County Highways have been informed. A speed count is currently taking place at Daws House.
- 11/087 Bangors Tip Excavations on the site have revealed a seam of Cornish slate bedrock. Completion is expected to be in October. Cllr Parsons is to look at a Sita site at Exeter combines both rubbish and re-use.
- 11/088 Bus Shelter The invoice has been received, a letter of thanks is to be sent to the builder Gavin Smith.
- 11/089 Old School House The contract for the use of the car park has been received from the Diocesan Board of Education's solicitors. Councillor Whiting advised on alterations which Councillors discussed and agreed to. It was proposed by Cllr Screech that Cllr Whiting write to the Diocesan Board's solicitors asking for changes in the contract, proposal seconded by Cllr Parsons, proposal carried.
- 11/090 Parish Event Cllr Mrs Archer and Cllr Parsons are to liaise on this matter.
- 11/091 Play Project There is no further news on this matter.
- 11/092 Aggregate Levy Fund A reply has been received from Mr Dan Rogerson MP and from HM Treasury. £299,000,000 will be raised in 2010/11. This will go into the government's Consolidated Fund. DEFRA will receive £18,000,000 to distribute.
- 11/093 Village Shop A public meeting is to be held on May 18th where the results of the questionnaire will be discussed and the next move decided.
- 11/094 SPIVS It was proposed by Cllr Parsons that Mr Owen Goodman be asked to attend to the flower boxes on the toilets the parish council to pay for the planting, proposal seconded by Cllr Patterson, proposal carried.
- 11/095 Cornwall Council Cllr Parsons reported that the new parking charges have now come into force, the charge for 1 hour has been reduced to 50p, the charge for 2 hours is £1.20. A meeting of School Governors, Head Teachers and County Councillors is to take place to discuss the future of schools in Launceston.

- 11/096 Audit Mrs Packer is to audit the accounts next week
- 11/097 Insurance Cllr Patterson advised that in light of the refurbishment, the insurance value of the bus shelter be increased, he queried the insurance of the War Memorial, the parish clerk is to look into this. Cllr Patterson also recommended that the parish council insure this year with Zurich Insurance, it was proposed by Cllr Parsons that Cllr Patterson's recommendations be acted on, proposal seconded by Cllr Screech, proposal carried.
- 11/098 Footpaths The parish clerk has still not received the contract for 2011/12 from Cornwall Council.
- 11/099 Annual Parish Meeting The parish clerk is to send out invitations to attend the Annual Parish Meeting to the secretaries of village organisations. Cllr Parsons suggested that an invitation be sent to the new Mayor of Launceston, this will be done.
